The following information details ways to ensure success with the Tupelo Public School District Distance Learning Plan through online lessons or through the paper/pencil learning packets.

*Online learning opportunities and paper/pencil packets are being offered to all students. It is not recommended that your child completes both. We do not want to overwhelm students or families during this time. Please note the packets are intended to be used over a four week time period.

*If you have questions or need support in accessing the online instruction or completing the paper/pencil packet, please contact your child's teacher. In Google Classroom and in the information mailed to you, there is a list of email addresses if you would like to email your child's teacher.

*Your child's teacher will periodically contact you to support your child's learning.

*Contact your child's teacher if your child is confused when completing daily lessons.
Teachers will be available 8:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m., Monday-Friday, for support.

*Supporting your child by providing a quiet space to work and informing him or her of the daily tasks will be helpful in ensuring success.

*Please be reminded that your child should work these at his or her own pace. Your child may need more time for daily lessons. Extending beyond one day while working through the online lessons or the paper/pencil packets is fine. Meet the needs of your child and make learning fun.

*Please continue to read with your child daily. Ask questions about what he or she has read.
