- The Golden Wave are back at home for an important division clash with defending state champion Madison Central as they begin the final stretch of the regular season.
- 10th meeting between Tupelo & Madison Central...THS has lost last 2...Last W, 27-15 at MCHS in '13.
- Madison Central is coming off a 38-31 loss at home to Clinton other loss was at Brandon 28-7 wk2.
- Tupelo aims for first 8-0 start since 2017...'17 team went undefeated in the regular season.
- THS has allowed just 40 points in their first 7 games, fewest since they allowed 42 through their first seven during the '90 season, when THS went 12-2, falling in the title game to Meridian. (1987 team allowed just 39 points in their first 7 games).
- Tupelo is coming off their closest game of the season a 24-17 win on the road against a determined Starkville squad (first win over Starkville since 2008)...Tupelo led 14-10 at half...Game was tied at 17 with 10:26 remaining - THS scored on a 59 yd pass from Harrell to Middlebrooks with 9:20 remaining...defense clinched the game at midfield with a strip sack by Jamarion Scott.
- Tupelo trailed for the first time in '22 after a Braden Green FG made it 10-7 SHS with 2:06 left in Q1.
- It was the 2nd stragiht game that Tupelo's offense went for over 300 yds.
- BIG PLAY QUA Qua Middlebrooks 15 car, 56 yds with 1 TD + 3 catches for 87 yds, 1 TD. .
- PIVOTAL PUNTS Offense started in SHS territory and scored 2 TDs in 1st H on short fields bad snap on punt started a drive at Starkville 15, then a Gideon Deaton punt pinned SHS @ 1 yd line which resulted in a short field after a 3-and-out. Deaton hit a 35-yd FG in Q3 to make it 17-10 THS.
- SCOTT SWATS JACKETS Jamarion Scott led THS with 9 tackles, 3 TFL, 2 forced fumbles, 1 fum • rec, 1 pass break up. LA Ray finished with 9 tackles, 1 sack, 1 TFL.
- Starkville was able to hit big plays vs. Tupelo D ran for 217 yds on 40 carries, and threw for 107.
- Second consecutive game that Tupelo's offense totaled over 300 yards.
- **KEY STOP** D was able to hold SHS to FG after false start moved SHS from 1 to 6 on 3rd & goal.
- Tupelo has forced atleast 1 turnover in every game this season...forced 2 or more in 4 of 7 games.
- The Golden Wave will host 3 of their last 4 games only a trip to Murrah next week remains.
- Offensively, Tupelo has scored on 17 of 19 trips to the redzone this season, 15 TDs, 2 FGs.
- Rankings: MS Gridiron #5 in Overall Top 10...SB Live MS #4 in Power 10 state wide.
- HOLDING AT THE TOP: Daily Journal has Tupelo at #1 in their Large School Top 10.

### **COACHING STAFF**

### **HEAD COACH TY HARDIN**

Tv Hardin, enters his third season at the helm of the Golden Wave. He was announced as Tupelo High School's 27th head football coach in school history on May 5th, 2020.

Hardin previously held the head coach position from 2016-2019 for the (3A, now 4A) Houston Hilltoppers, the school he graduated from. There Hardin amassed a 37-14 record over four seasons and helped Houston claim their second division championship in program history in 2018. While at Houston, Coach Hardin won 73% of their district games.

Coach Hardin was hired in the middle of the COVID-19 pandemic and despite those challenges, led the Golden Wave to a 6-5 record and a playoff berth in his first season. Unfortunately, the Golden Wave were forced to forfeit their first round game against Warren Central due to

His second season began with the Golden Wave firing out to a 5-0 start before finishing the season 7-4 without clinching a playoff bid. 2 of Tupelo's four losses came by 7 points or fewer.

Coach Hardin refers to Class 6 Division 2 as the "SEC West" of high school football. The talent, teams, and coaching in this division make the margin between winning and losing as thin as anywhere in the country.
