PSE Technology Information Sheet

Classlink is a site where Tupelo students can go to access most school apps, such as Canvas and iReady. To get to the Classlink homepage, students can first go to www.tupeloschools.com, then hover over Teaching and Learning, finally click on Resources. Classlinks is located at the top of the 3-5 weblink (middle column). Once students click on the Classlink link, they will login with Google. This should take them to their LaunchPad, where useful apps are housed.

iReady

To access iReady, students will first need to log in to Classlink. IReady is one of the apps on the Classlink LaunchPad. Students click on the app then select the subject they would like to work on. This year, students will be given a daily grade for their iReady work. Students are required to have 45 minutes of time on task each week, in each subject, reading and math. Students will also need to have an 80% or higher score to receive full credit. Ample time is given in class to complete the required time on task each week; however, iReady is a very solid tool and any extra time given to iReady would be beneficial to students. To monitor your child's progress, have your student log on to iReady and click on the subject area you would like to monitor. Then click on "My Progress." This shows the amount of time on task and the percentage correct. Remember the quality of work completed is just as important as the time on task.

O----- Canvas ------O

To access Canvas, students will need to log in to Classlink. Canvas is one of the apps on the Classlink LaunchPad. Students will click on the Canvas app, which will then take them to their Canvas Dashboard. Here, students will see their different classes. To monitor your students' Canvas activity, parents can download the Canvas Parent app. Once the app downloads, click on "find school." Type in "Tupelo Public School District-Parent." Next, click on "Create an Account." You will need to create a pairing code on your student's account. To create the pairing code, students click on "Account." Next students click on "Settings." Then click on "Pair with observer" a pairing code will appear. Enter that in the parent canvas app.

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
